

## ITEM Automated Inmate Public Telephone Service 110.22

#### 1. Service Description

Automated Inmate Public Telephone Service enables inmates in the confines of a correctional or penal institution to make local or long distance calls from a public telephone. Local or long distance calls made using an Automated Inmate Public Telephone Service are placed as collect calls.

Automated Inmate Public Telephone Service allows the Correctional Centre's administration to control the inmates' telephone privileges by:

- (a) blocking access to certain telephone numbers or services,
- (b) limiting access to specific telephone numbers,
- (c) limiting the duration of calls,
- (d) restricting the use to specified periods of the day, or
- (e) delivering a recorded announcement stating that the call originates from a correctional institute.

Call detail information may be furnished to the institution, and calls may be monitored and recorded consistent with Federal and Provincial laws with respect to the authority granted to the administration of correctional and penal institutions.

#### 2. Conditions of Service

1. Automated Inmate Public Telephone Service is provided at the request of the Correctional Centre's administration and is subject to the availability of suitable facilities.
