

SASKTEL BIOSECURITY POLICY

SaskTel is committed to protecting your land and your crops from soil-borne diseases such as clubroot when we are performing any services on your property.



OUR BIOSECURITY POLICY:

1. Where possible, we will avoid access to agricultural land.
2. When access to agricultural land is required, SaskTel staff and agents will evaluate projects for their apparent biosecurity risk, follow a series of preventative actions and cleaning protocols to minimize the movement of soil containing clubroot spores.

PREVENTATIVE ACTIONS:

- When possible, agricultural land will be accessed by foot. Vehicles and equipment will only be used when necessary.
- All inspection and sanitization efforts will be documented.
- Construction in wet areas will be avoided when possible.
- Equipment and vehicles entering agricultural land will be inspected and cleaned if needed prior to arriving on a project. There are three levels of cleaning that may be used depending on the project circumstances: mechanical cleaning, washing, and disinfecting.
