ITEM Standby Circuits

1. Service Description

A Standby Circuit is an interconnecting circuit with line or trunk side access which has been activated but rendered incapable, by SaskTel, of carrying traffic.

2. Conditions of Service

- 1. All requests to establish standby circuits and to subsequently remove the standby condition must be addressed to SaskTel's Carrier Services Group.
- 2. Upon removal of the standby condition, standby circuits may be used only for the type of service specified in the original order which established them (Eg: PSTN connectivity, Toll-Free connection, and Feature Group D).

3. Rates

- 1. SaskTel will furnish standby circuits at the rates and charges referenced in 1 E of the Interconnecting Circuits with Trunk Side Access tariff and in the appropriate General Tariff services that may be used to provide interconnecting circuits with line side access.
- 2. The only service charge associated with the establishment of a standby circuit, is the one to activate the appropriate connection or access as follows:(a) For interconnecting circuits with line side access:
 - The services charges for PSTN connectivity found in the Digital Exchange Access tariff and toll service connections apply, as appropriate.
 - (b) For interconnecting circuits with trunk side access, the service charge is that specified for an Inward Order in 1F of the Interconnecting Circuits with Trunk Side Access tariff.

3. Rates – Continued

- 3. Designation of an active circuit to standby and removal of the standby condition are each subject to the appropriate charges as follows:
 - (a) For interconnecting circuits with line side access: A minimum service charge of \$45.00 per customer order (request) plus a service charge per circuit equal to the service charge to establish the interconnecting circuit.
 - (b) For interconnecting circuits with trunk side access: Change Order charge as specified in number 1F of the Interconnecting Circuits with Trunk Side Access tariff.
