  - (a) Access,
  - (b) link, and
  - (c) channel

link-multi-drop	The switching centre equipment required to

channel	The digital facility between switching centres.

- 3. A customer who has a contract for DCS is allowed to add a drop (leg) on a monthly rental basis.
- 4. Monthly rental rates apply to each drop added. This monthly rental leg is allowed to be terminated without penalty prior to the contract termination date.
- 5. A customer may not substitute contracted legs with monthly rental legs.
- 6. This service is only available where suitable facilities exist.
- 7. If suitable facilities are not available, the Customer will be required to pay SaskTel's incremental costs to provide such facilities.
