



# ITEM Service Interface 150.10

## 1. Service Description

Service Interface extends facilities from the SaskTel network interface demarcation point to a common location (i.e. telephone closet) in order to allow the customer access to SaskTel's network.

Service Interface is the facility by which network access services is extended beyond the network interface via existing riser cable pairs to a common location, or a complex wire cross connect point, i.e. communications termination closet. The termination in the communication closet is called the Service Interface.

## 2. Conditions of Service

- 1. The Service Interface applies:
  - (a) to business customers who approach SaskTel to lease an existing in place SaskTel owned riser facility.
  - (b) Any business service customer changes physical address and location
  - (c) Any business service customer adds a new circuit (only the new circuits will be required to lease Service Interface to extend service through SaskTel owned riser cable)

#### 2. Service Interface does not apply:

- (a) when there is no SaskTel owned riser facility in place,
- (b) when there is only customer owned riser facilities in place,
- (c) to existing single line business customer's who had previously been exempt.

# **Service Interface – Continued**

#### 3. Rates

The Customer shall pay to SaskTel the following rates and charges for Service Interface. Such rates and charges are in addition to any other rates and charges that may be applicable.

Service	<b>Monthly Rental</b>	Service Charge
Service Interface (per pair)	\$2.35	Service Interface is established with Network Access, there is no service charge.

**Note:** Any installs, moves, changes or modifications to Service Interface requested by the customer will be carried out at \$89.00/hour (minimum ½ hour) billed in ¼ hour increments. Chargeable hours are measured portal to portal which includes such things as labour, transportation and consumable parts.
