

2016 SaskTel Student Campaign Free Tuition Promotion  
Official Rules

1. The 2016 Student Campaign Free Tuition Promotion runs from May 29, 2016 to October 15, 2016 (“Promotion Period”).
2. All entries must be received before the end of the Promotion Period being October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2016 at 11:59 pm. SaskTel accepts no responsibility and will not be liable for entries that are not received, incomplete, lost, late, or misdirected for whatever reason.
3. SaskTel will make a random draw on or about October 21<sup>st</sup>, 2016 from all eligible entries received for the prizes. Chances of winning are dependent on the number of eligible entries received. Chosen entrants must correctly answer a time limited mathematical skill testing question before being declared a winner.
4. This Promotion is subject to all applicable federal and provincial laws.
5. SaskTel is the sole judge and decision maker regarding any dispute about the application or interpretation of the Rules or any other aspect of the Promotion and the judgment or decision of SaskTel shall be final.

**How to enter**

Each entrant subscribing to SaskTel infiNET High Speed Mach 1 or High Speed Ultra Internet Service, maxTV™ Basic Service or an applicable SaskTel Wireless rate plan\* (Ultimate 75, Ultimate 90, and Ultimate 105) before the Promotion Closing Date of October 15, 2016 will automatically receive an entry for each such SaskTel service the entrant subscribes to. Each entrant can qualify for a maximum of three (3) entries.

\*Eligible Wireless rate plans subject to change throughout the promotion.

**Eligibility**

1. This Contest is only open to Saskatchewan residents who are 18 years of age or older and who are currently enrolled and taking classes at a post secondary education facility in Saskatchewan except:
  - a. SaskTel employees or member of their families or those with whom they reside; and
  - b. Any dealers/dealer employees and their immediate families or those with whom they reside.
2. If you are a SaskTel customer and you are chosen as a potential winner, in order to be eligible to win, your SaskTel account must be in good standing with SaskTel at the time of the draw. “In good standing” means a customer who has an account with as of the

draw date and whose account balance is not outstanding over 59 days or suspended for non-payment.

### **Prizes**

1. There will be two prizes of a tuition reimbursement up to a maximum of \$7000 each.
2. If the winner cannot be reached within five (5) days of the draw date, he/she will be deemed to have forfeited his/her opportunity to win, and a new winner will be chosen
3. All entries become the property of SaskTel, and will not be returned.
4. By entering the Promotion, entrants are deemed to have read and agreed with these Rules and release SaskTel, its employees and their agents from any and all liability resulting from the Promotion and any use of the prizes.
5. Only the winners selected in the Draw will be contacted by SaskTel.
6. SaskTel shall make the final determination on the eligibility of all entries.
7. As a winner, you consent to the publication of your name in a list of the winners on various communication platforms as reasonably determined by SaskTel.
8. No communications will take place except with entrants selected in the draw as potential or actual winners.

### **Prize redemption and exchange**

1. To be eligible to claim a prize, the selected winner must provide evidence satisfactory to SaskTel of enrollment on a post secondary educational institution in Saskatchewan.
2. An entrant can only win one prize.
3. The value of each prize will be determined on the basis of the tuition only fees paid by the winner in the fall 2016 semester multiplied by two (2).
4. In order to claim a prize, the winning party must provide SaskTel with the following information:
