

## Message Toll Calls

## Description

Message toll calls are any long distance calls placed via a Public or Semi-Public Telephone.

**Reference**: Refer to the regulated General Tariff Basic Services on Public Telephone Service and Semi-Public Telephone Service.

## Rates

The Customer shall pay to SaskTel the following rates and charges for each message toll call made from Public Telephone Service equipment or Semi-Public Telephone Service equipment. Such rates and charges are in addition to any other rates and charges that may be applicable.

a)	Paid for using coins	\$2.00 per call, plus \$1.00 per minute
b)	Using an authorized payphone prepaid cash card	Charge as specified by card provider
c)	Using a valid long distance prepaid phone card	Charge as specified by card provider

e)	Billed to a commercial credit card,

•	Canada and U.S.	• \$2.00 per call, plus \$0.99 per minute or portion thereof
•	Mexico and Overseas	• \$4.00 per call, plus the Basic Toll Schedule Rate
•	Operator Assisted Surcharge	• \$2.00 per call*
f)	Billed as collect call	Applicable Operator Surcharge applies, plus
	i. Station to station	the Basic Toll Schedule Rate
	ii. Person to person	
g)	Billed to a third party number	Applicable Operator Surcharge applies, plus the Basic Toll Schedule Rate

\* In cases where the credit card call is not able to be completed via the automated verification process, the call is re-routed to an operator. If the call can then be completed via the assistance of the operator, the additional surcharge applies.
